AA KK	<p>Early position LIMP.</p> <p>IF... someone raises THEN... you can either call them and let them bet the hand out and play a passive role OR... you can push.</p> <p>It's your choice.</p>	<p>IF ... the flop makes a set THEN... give them a chance to bet into you.</p> <p>You can choose to push if you think they will call or simply call and let them keep betting.</p>	<p>IF... You have KK and an A flops THEN... get out of the hand – This is a Cards Game. You have to let this go.</p>	<p>Call any reasonable bet up to the pot as long as an overcard doesn't hit or the board doesn't make 4 to a flush or straight.</p> <p>FOLD to any bet over the pot size.</p>	Same as turn
AK	<p>LIMP and call any raise up to 5xBB</p>	<p>IF... you flop top pair THEN... check/call</p> <p>Even if there are draws.</p>	<p>FOLD to anything but a token bet of 1-3BB.</p>	<p>With TPTK Call any reasonable bet up to the pot as long as an overcard doesn't hit or the board doesn't make 4 to a flush or straight.</p> <p>FOLD to any bet over the pot size.</p>	Same as turn

<p>22-QQ</p>	<p>LIMP and call any raise up to 5xBB</p>	<p>IF... You flop a set THEN... You can choose to push if you think they will call or simply call and let them keep betting.</p> <p>IF... you have an overpair (a pair higher than the highest card on the board) THEN... check/call up to the ½ size of the pot.</p> <p>Even if there are draws.</p>	<p>FOLD to anything but a token bet of 1-3BB.</p>	<p>With a set or better then you can choose to push if you think they will call or simply call and let them keep betting.</p> <p>With an overpair you can call up to ½ pot</p> <p>IF... an overcard hits and you just have a poker pair THEN... fold.</p>	<p>Same as turn</p>
<p>SUITED CONNECTORS TJ AND ABOVE</p>	<p>Limp and only call a raise of up to 3xBB if there are at least 2 other players in the hand. Fold to any reraise.</p>	<p>IF... you flop a straight or flush THEN... check/call any bet</p> <p>IF... you flop and open ended straight draw or a flush draw THEN... call any bet up to 25% of the pot OR... fold to any bet if you believe someone playing behind you will raise the original bettor.</p> <p>(If you flop top pair, see Missed flop).</p>	<p>FOLD if you miss the flop entirely.</p> <p>IF... you flopped top pair THEN... only call token bets of 1-3BB UNLESS you have KQ and flop top pair then you can call up to ½ pot size bet if the pot was unraised preflop.</p>	<p>IF... you have a straight or flush THEN... check/call any bet</p> <p>IF... you have an open ended straight draw or a flush draw THEN... call any bet up to 25% of the pot OR... fold to any bet if you believe someone playing behind you will raise the original bettor.</p> <p>(If you turn top pair, see Missed flop).</p>	<p>IF... you have a straight or flush THEN... check/raise 1x pot any bet (if you think someone will bet after you) OR... Bet ½ - 1x pot (if you are in late position or think no one else will bet)</p> <p>OTHERWISE FOLD.</p> <p>(If you flop a pair, see Missed flop).</p>
